Tiverton Swimming Club Masters swimmer Sue Haigh had the honour of representing Great Britain at the 2017 World Masters Swimming Championships in Budapest in August this year. Swimming in the 65-69 age group Sue put in some fantastic performances and was rewarded with bronze medals in the 800m freestyle, 400m freestyle, 200m freestyle and finished fourth in the 100m butterfly. Squad name change

We have changed the name of one of our training squads from non-competitive to Competitive Development squad (CD) This is to reflect the development pathway swimmers take when moving from Skill Development (SD) squad training 3 hours a week to the next level of Competitive development at 4.5 hours a week, and then moving to the competitive (Comp) squad who have 6.5 hours of pool time available to train each week. We encourage all swimmers to train at as many sessions available to them to get the most out of their swimmer development as possible.

Nine volunteers trained as timekeepers for the club in July and were able to put their new found skills to the test at the Club Championships Level 4 licenced meet this year.
